Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) Revision
USA to North Europe, Mediterranean,
Middle East, Persian Gulf and Red Sea**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to the fluctuating price of oil, effective **January 1st, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will adjust the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) for all export cargo moving from all the U.S. origins to all destinations in North Europe, Baltic, Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, East Mediterranean, West Mediterranean, Adriatic, Black Sea, North Africa, Red Sea and Persian Gulf, as follows:

USD \$152.00 per 20' Container (all types)
USD \$304.00 per 40' Container (all types)

Please note that the new EFS amount will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of January 1st 2010.
