Terminal Handling Charge (THC)
China to the U.S.
Effective January, 2010

Dear valued customers,

Effective **January 11th, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will increase the Terminal Handling Charge (THC) for all cargo moving from all China provinces (excluding the provinces of Guangdong, Guanxi, Hainan, Yunnan, and Hong Kong) to the United States. The THC will increase to the following amounts:

China THC Levels

RMB ¥470 20' (standard, open top, refrigerated and flat rack)

RMB ¥755 40' (standard, high cube, open top, refrigerated and flat rack)

RMB ¥955 45'
