



Customer Advisory #14 – 2010
Reminder: Chinese Customs Advanced Manifest Regulation (CCAM)
Original Effective Date: January, 2009

Dear Valued Customer,

This advisory is to serve as a reminder of the Chinese Customs Advanced Manifest (CCAM) Regulation, first introduced in January, 2009. This regulation required that CMA CGM submit a complete cargo manifest to Chinese Customs at least 24 hours prior to loading cargo onto vessels for all cargo with a first discharge port in China. This applies to all shipments direct to (or transshipping via) China from any foreign port. Notification was previously sent out under [Customer Advisory #178-2008](#).

The informed compliance period is quickly coming to an end. Upon full enforcement, once the electronic manifest is submitted to Chinese Customs, CMA CGM will receive either an approval to load or request to hold cargo at POL.

In order to comply with this regulation and ensure that your cargo is able to be loaded, our published documentation cutoff will be adjusted. The documentation cutoff for any cargo that falls under the CCAM regulation will be 2 business days prior to the Operational Cutoff at the port.

To ensure that your cargo is loaded, full shipping instructions are required by close of business on the documentation cutoff. The following pieces of information are required on your Shipping Instructions (SI) in order to comply with both US Customs and Chinese Customs Advanced Manifest regulations:

- Voyage number
- Payment terms
- Total number of packages
- Type of Package
- Cargo weight
- Shipper/Forwarder name & address

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- Consignee/Notify name & address
- Container size & type
- Container number(s)
- Type of inner packaging
- Number of inner packages
- Cargo description
- Gross weight by commodity item
- Internal transaction number (ITN)
