USA to North Europe, Mediterranean, Middle East, and Red Sea
Effective March, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **March 1st, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will adjust the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) for all export cargo moving from all U.S. origins to all destinations in North Europe, Baltic, Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, East Mediterranean, West Mediterranean, Adriatic, Black Sea, North Africa, Red Sea and Persian Gulf, as follows:

USD \$156.00 / 20' Container (all types)
USD \$312.00 / 40' Container (all types)

Please note that the new EFS will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port on or after March 1, 2010.
