Bunker Adjustment Factor (BAF)
USEC & USGC to South Pacific Islands
Effective March, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **March 1st, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will increase the Bunker Adjustment Factor (BAF) for all cargo moving from the East Coast and Gulf Coast of the United States to the South Pacific Islands as follows:

**USD \$790 / 20' container (all types)
USD \$1580 / 40' container (all types)**

The new BAF will be applied on all dry, refrigerated, exempt, and non-exempt commodities moving under a CMA CGM bill of Lading on or after March 1, 2010.
