Port Congestion Surcharge Update (PCS)
U.S. to North Africa
Effective March, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **March 5th, 2010**, due to ongoing worsening of the congestion situation at the ports of Oran, Algeria, and Benghazi, Libya, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a Port Congestion Surcharge (PCS) for all shipments from the United States to the above mentioned ports as follows:

Oran: USD \$75 / 20' container (all types)
USD \$150 / 40' container (all types)

Benghazi: USD \$60 / 20' container (all types)
USD \$120 / 40' container (all types)

The existing PCS will be maintained for the port of Tripoli, Libya.

Tripoli: USD \$160 / 20' container (all types)
USD \$320 / 40' container (all types)

****Effective immediately**, the PCS for Algerian ports of Algiers and Bejaia will be reduced to the following levels:

Algiers: USD \$250 / 20' container (all types)
USD \$500 / 40' container (all types)

Bejaia: USD \$25 / 20' container (all types)
USD \$50 / 40' container (all types)

Please note that the above surcharges will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port as of the dates mentioned above.
