Equipment Imbalance Surcharge – Houston & New Orleans
Effective February, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **February 4th, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will institute the following Equipment Imbalance Surcharge for export cargo loading from Houston and New Orleans to North Europe, Baltic, Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, Red Sea, Black Sea, Adriatic, East Mediterranean, and **Libyan** Ports.

USD \$150.00	20' Container (all types)
USD \$200.00	40' Container (all types)

This charge excludes shipper owned equipment (i.e. dry or tank containers), and will cover cargos moving under both tariff and service contract rates. Charges will be applied upon all export cargo received at store door, rail ramp or port on or after of February 4, 2010.
