



**Customer Advisory #52 – 2010
Quebec Spring Thaw Reminder
Effective March, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please note that the 2010 Spring Thaw Season in Quebec, Canada has been advanced to commence on March 8th, and end on March 29th. These dates are approximate, and can vary with one day notice.

The Ministere des Transports du Quebec reminds heavy vehicle users and shippers that, as with each year, authorized load limits are reduced during the spring thaw period in order to account for the weaker load bearing capacity of the road network. The following weight restrictions will apply during this period:

Dry containers

Reefer containers
