Port au Prince, Haiti
Resume Service and Port Surcharge Reminder
Effective March, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **immediately**, CMA CGM (Caribbean) LLC will resume service to Port au Prince, Haiti. A regular service with transshipment in Kingston, Jamaica will now be resumed with a dedicated CMA CGM feeder under the following conditions:

- **Effective March 14th, 2010**, a **Port au Prince Port Surcharge of USD \$500 / TEU** will be implemented for all container types and sizes (except OOG and IMO) shipped to or via Port au Prince, Haiti.
- Freight and DTHC must be **PREPAID** at the place of booking.
- Prior to booking, the **freight acceptance confirmation** must be requested and obtained from our agency in Haiti, so that the consignee is able to take delivery of the cargo.
