Effective February 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement the following tariff Bunker Surcharge (BSC) from Indian Subcontinent Ports and Points (India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh), and East Africa Ports and Points (Kenya, Tanzania, Mozambique, Mauritius, Madagascar, and Mayotte) (Tariff 029) to U.S. East Coast and Gulf Coast ports, and all U.S. inland points served by these ports.
