Waiver Control

- A waiver is not necessary. BSC / CTN is not required.

Pre-Shipment Inspection

- Pre-shipment inspection is not required for shipments into Cape Verde.
- The commercial invoice for the goods either in Portuguese or in English translated to Portuguese should accompany the shipment.
- Requirements for Customs clearance: commercial invoice, Bs/I and a Declaration of Importation (TCE) issued locally.
- Requirements for release of the cargo at the port: Customs clearance and original of Bs/L, dully stamped (with release permission) by ship's agent.
