# EQUATORIAL GUINEA >> Regulation Overview

## Waiver Control

- A waiver is at present not necessary. BSC / CTN is not required.

There has been an on-going debate about the introduction of ECTN/BESC. The Ministry of Finance and Budget of Equatorial Guinea is discussing the possible introduction of ECTN or Formulario Electrónico para el Seguimiento de Operaciones (FESO) for all shipments to and from the country. A July 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 implementation date was suggested but the move has been **postponed till further notice!**

## Pre-Shipment Inspection

- There is presently no PSI/DI required for shipments to Equatorial Guinea

## Prohibited Imports

- Weapons
- Military Equipment

## Restricted Imports

Used vehicles imports are restricted to obtain 2 special authorisations stamped and signed, they are issued by ministry of Mines and Customs Administration in Malabo.
