

## "Military Cargo and affiliated" means any cargo falling within any one or more of the following categories:

- Cargo which is specially designed or modified for military use;
- Cargo which is listed on the Wassenaar Arrangement's "Munitions List" or "List of dual-use
  goods and technologies", at the date of shipping. This includes, but is not limited to weapons,
  ammunition, armoured cargo, military vehicles and ancillary equipment, non-lethal military
  equipment, protective clothing, paramilitary police equipment, as well as replicas and parts of
  any of the foregoing;
- Cargo which may be subject to a military or dual-use export/import licence or authorization, including licence exception, under the national laws and regulations of the exporting country;
- Cargo of any nature whatsoever shipped by or on behalf of and/or consigned to and/or ultimately destined for any person or entity, whether public or private, which is directly or indirectly connected to any defense or law enforcement body or agency whether governmental or otherwise;
- Production means related to any of the foregoing, including but not limited to any materials and equipment which may be used in the manufacture, maintenance and/or production of weapons, ammunitions, armoured cargo, military vehicles and ancillary equipment, non-lethal military equipment, protective clothing, paramilitary police equipment, as well as replicas

## Specific conditions applied to shipments of "Military Cargo and affiliated" under any Bill of Lading issued by a carrier within the CMA CGM Group:

- Customer must provide the completed information chart to submit a quotation request to their sales contact within CMA CGM agency network (Details to be submitted by CMA CGM Sales contact to Head Office dedicated department for feasibility and pricing);
- Shipments of "Military Cargo and affiliated" must be clearly declared in writing form at time of making a booking reservation together with the communication of all required documentation;
- Cargo loading final acceptance is subject to Head Office dedicated department written final approval;
