

General Terms and Conditions invoices CMA CGM Belgium NV – agent of CMA CGM SA

- 1) These general terms and conditions apply to all agreements entered into with CMA CGM Belgium NV, or to any agreement entered into by CMA CGM Belgium NV on behalf of CMA CGM SA. Any clauses which deviate from them must be expressly agreed in writing for each agreement separately.
- 2) Except for different express written agreement, all invoices are payable upon receipt. Payment in foreign currency (other than EURO) is only permitted if these currencies are mentioned on the invoice.
- 3) Part payment of the invoice is always deemed an agreement to keep in with the full outstanding amount of the invoice subject to timely protest was lodged, in accordance with article 4 of the general terms and conditions.
- 4) Any complaint regarding an invoice issued by CMA CGM Belgium NV is only valid if it reaches CMA CGM Belgium NV in written form, at latest within 7 working days of the invoice date. If the invoice is not disputed in the set period and form, the invoice will be deemed to have been accepted..
- 5) CMA CGM SA en/of CMA CGM Belgium NV have a right of lien over any goods and/or documents which come into their possession, as security for any claims against the debtor. These goods and/or documents also serve as a pledge for debts in the sense of the Law of 5 May 1872 relating to pledges and commission.
- 6) Failure to fulfil the payment obligations shall, as a matter of law and without any advance notice of default, result in interest of 1% per month being charged on top of the invoice sum. In addition, 10% of the invoice sum, with a minimum of € 125.00 will be charged as a fixed sum of compensation, without prejudice to the recoverability of any legal costs.
- 7) Subject to express written deviation, the legal relationship between CMA CGM Belgium NV and the addressee mentioned on this invoice is fully governed by Belgian Law. The Courts of Antwerp are solely competent to hear any legal claims arising out of the collection of unpaid invoices.
